Sonu's leadership in sustainable luxury earned him recognition as an Officer of the Order of the British Empire (OBE) and the SevenRooms.





Unlike the coins you find in your pocket, which are struck between two dies, the large precious metal coins are cut into a solid gold ingot by a state-of-the-art precision milling machine before the processes of polishing, and frosting are carried out by hand and using laser engraving technology. For our large coins, of 10 kilogrammes and 15 kilogrammes of fine gold, this hand craftsmanship is known to take 400 hours and the results are out of this world.



What are these coins worth?

The craftsmanship and finesse of our masterworks are second to none, combining unique works of art with intrinsic metal value. Each piece carries the heritage of The Royal Mint and involves hundreds of hours of hand work by our Master Craftspeople, enhancing key elements within the design. Each piece is different, but the larger coins can be worth six figures or more.

The biggest challenge right now is lack of inventory. It's tough to meet demands for buyers when their wants and needs aren't met by the market. Dyears of Magnum

The legendary agency Magnum Photos celebrated its 75th anniversary with a series of global events around the theme of "In Dialogue", centred around its Annual General Meeting in New York City. WORDS: Nick Rice

A co-operative that is owned and run by its member photographers, who undergo a rigorous process of self-selection in order to become full members, Magnum always meet at this time of year, either in New York, Paris or London, to discuss affairs and what next.

Magnum was founded in 1947 and ever since it has documented most of the world's major events and personalities, covering society, politics, and conflict. In his book Magnum Photos, Fred Ritchin writes, "Two years after the apocalypse that was called the Second World War ended, Magnum Photos was founded.

The world's most prestigious photographic agency was formed by four photographers – Robert Capa, Henri Cartier-Bresson, George Rodger and David "Chim" Seymour - who had been very much scarred by the conflict and were motivated both by a sense of relief that the world had somehow survived and the curiosity to see what was still there. They created Magnum in 1947 to reflect their independent natures as both people and photographers – the idiosyncratic mix of reporter and artist that continues to define Magnum, emphasising not only what is seen but also the way one sees it."

With its continued commitment to chronicling events, people, places and cultures across the world, celebrations and discussion have begun with a series of talk events at Photo London and retrospectives of Susan Meiselas and Bieke Depoorter at C/O Berlin.
